**Exercise & Training Committee:** The work of this committee includes the coordination of trainings for healthcare responders and supporting agencies in order to provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities needed to prepare and respond to a disaster.

**Information Sharing Committee:** The work of this committee includes the coordination and ability to conduct multijurisdictional, multidisciplinary exchange of public health and medical related information and situational awareness between the healthcare system and partners.

**Medical Surge Committee:** The work of this committee includes assisting the Region XI RHCC, Chair in providing adequate medical evaluation and care planning during incidents that exceed the limits of the normal medical infrastructure within the community. Those with particular interest and/or expertise in pediatrics are encouraged to participate. (Meets quarterly)

**Behavioral Health Subcommittee:** The work of this subcommittee includes developing, refining, and sustaining strategies to address the needs and challenges in emergency preparedness for both behavioral health populations and providers. (Meets quarterly)

**Responder Safety & Health:** The work of this committee includes developing, refining, and sustaining strategies to provide assistance to healthcare organizations with planning, equipping, or training to meet both decontamination and pharmaceutical anticipated needs.

**New Partners Workgroup:** This group will be formed in the coming grant year for the identified new partners to CHSPR, such as Long-Term Care Facilities, Dialysis Centers, FQHCs, etc. The group will be convened to address the new emergency preparedness requirements and subsequent issues facing facilities that are not hospitals. (Meetings are anticipated to begin in early 2018)

**Crisis Standards of Care:** This committee oversees a joint project with the Illinois Department of Public Health and partially supported by CHSCPR. This project addresses issues facing healthcare organizations and providers in the face of catastrophic-level incidents that significantly impact the level of care.
